

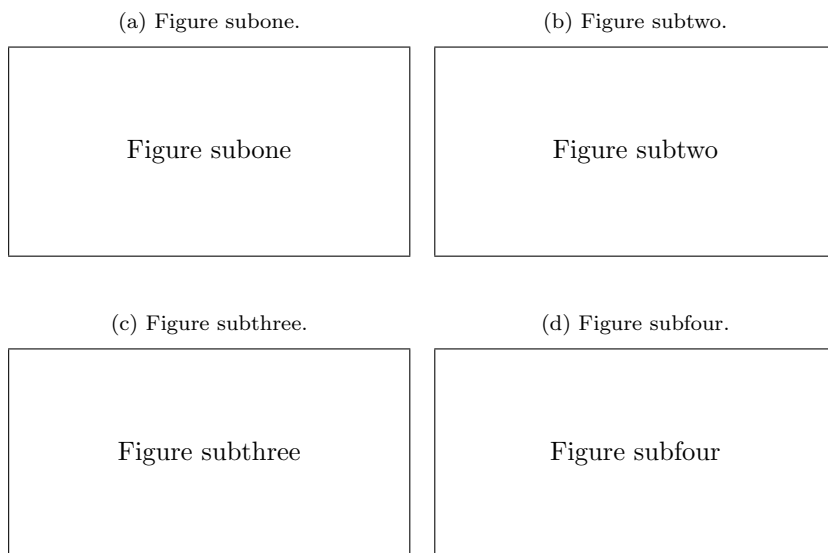

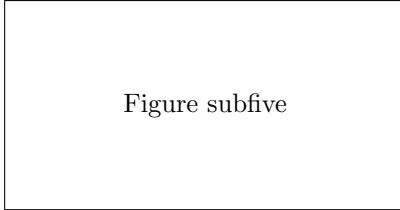
## 1 Seventh Test

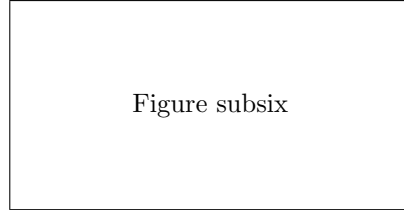
(We also need to check the test7.log file to insure that the problem was identified by the subfig package and a warning was issued.)

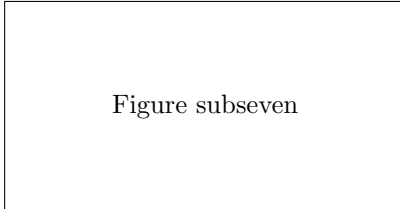

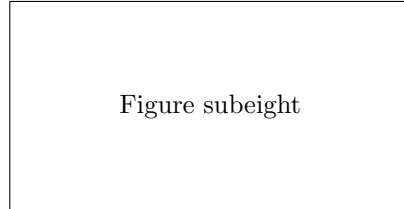
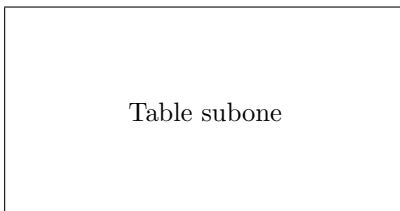
